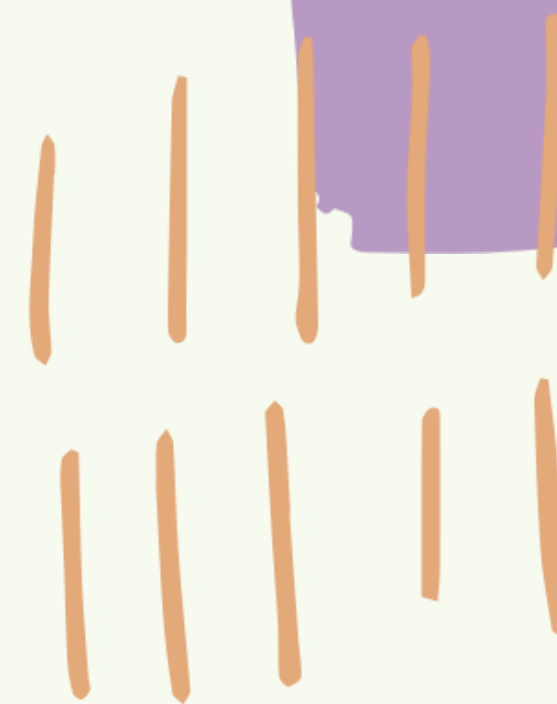

 - If you are unable to speak to us at the door then please feel free to email the office and they will forward it on to us.



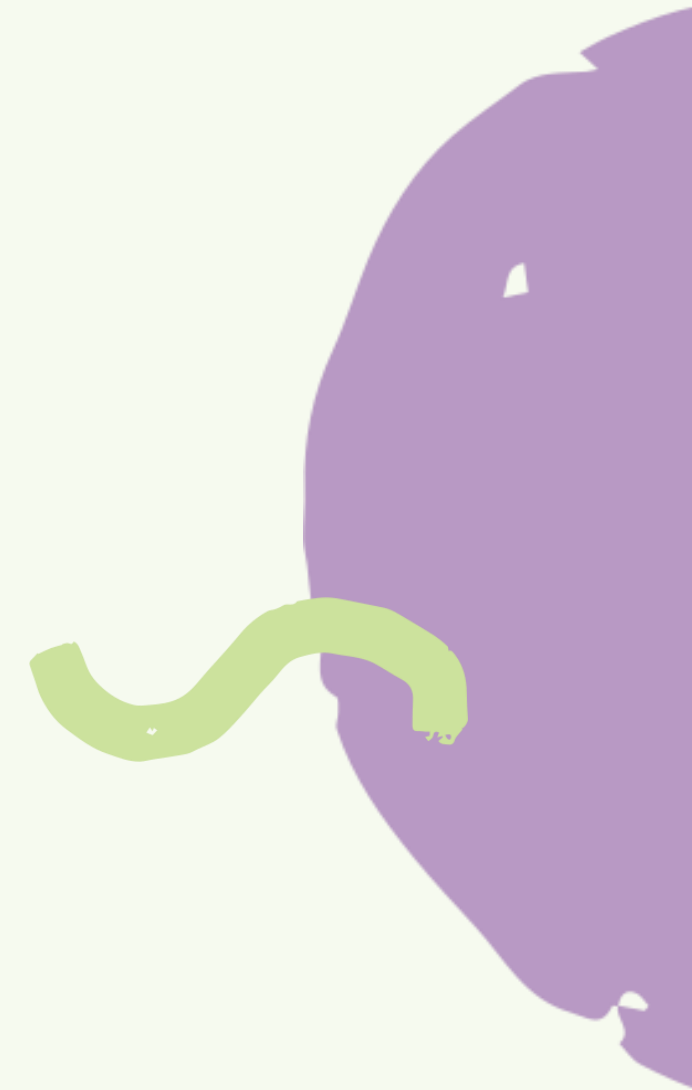
For our own wellbeing we will not respond to emails past 5.30pm. We will get back to you the following morning/ day.

PREPPING FOR THE SCHOOL DAY

- Pupils complete early morning learning in the mornings so please arrive at school on time.



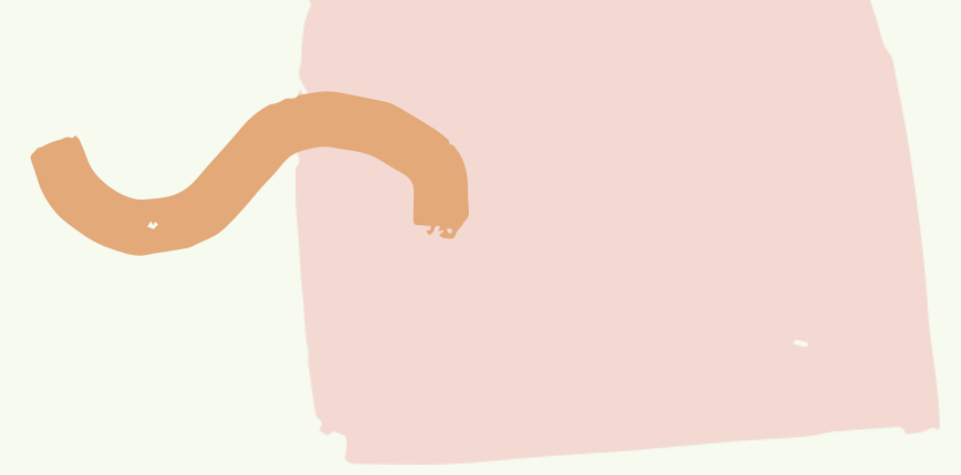


END OF DAY

- If it is anyone else collecting your child. You must let the office know or we are unable to release.
- If another parent helps collect your child regularly. Please let the office know at first and then us. This can then carry on for the school year. Please be aware that if for some reason you do not need or want that adult to continue to collect them. You must let us and the office know.
- If you need to speak to us at the end of the day this is possible. Or a meeting can be arranged through the office staff.
- If you would like your child to walk to you at the gate or walk home alone. An agreement must be signed. We will not even let children walk alone to meet you at any gate without this.

Your child can read at their own pace but teachers will be checking children are reading daily. This should be 20 minutes a day. This is why we need book and reading records to come in each day. Children can write in page numbers. A parent must sign to confirm.

HOME LEARNING- Reading

Accelerated Reader - Children will complete a Star Reader Assessment in school this week. This will then give them a ZPD score. Such as 3.2-4.1. This means they are able to go to the library and select a book numbered anywhere between this ZPD bracket.

Once they have chosen a book they can write in their own reading record the pages they have read each night. Once a book is completed children will let us know. They will then complete a quiz about the book on a class iPad. These will not be completed at home.

After the quiz is completed this will give them allow them to choose a new book. They cannot get a new book without completing the quiz.

There is not a set book change day for children on Accelerated Reader.

HOME LEARNING- Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling

Green home learning books are where you can practise spellings, time tables and complete weekly home learning and topic home learning. Green home learning books must be brought in on Thursdays. Every Week. We need them in to complete the spelling test and keep track of children's homework effort.

Spellings - These are taught and set on spelling shed on Friday's. They then practise all week at home and in school. Children in the class are set spellings at their level so please don't panic if another child in the class has different ones to yours. We then test every Thursday and the children write these in the back of the green home learning book.

You can check their green book for your child's spelling score. We also keep a track and may discuss with you if scores are fairly low a few weeks in a row to see how we can support your child in school and at home. There are ideas for spelling practise in the front of the green home learning book if you are struggling for ways to engage them. Please be aware spellings are set at your child's level so these may differ child to child. Log ins for spelling shed are in their yellow contact book.

GPS - Grammar and Punctuation - Weekly homework will be set and in their green book. this is looking to improve their knowledge of grammar and punctuation and refresh many skills they have learnt or will be learning. This will be marked or self marked on Friday's

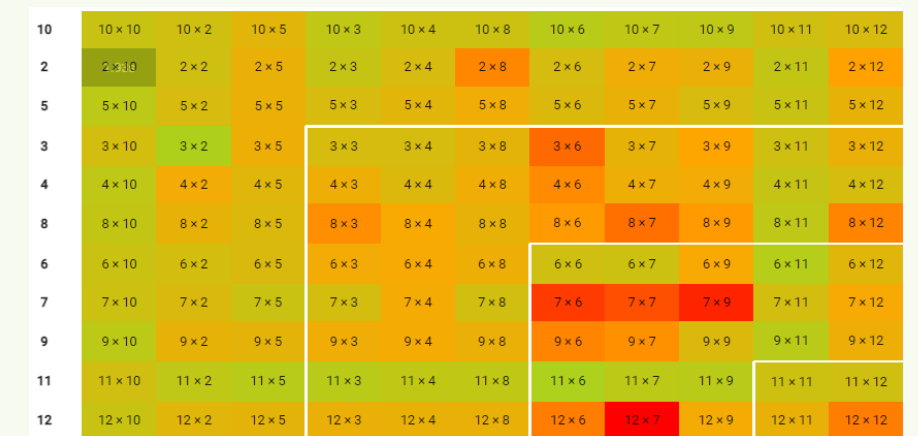


HOME LEARNING - Maths

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In the green home learning book you will find ways to practise them as well. Please do this as much as possible.

Children complete a TTRS baseline and depending on their knowledge shown they are set the relevant times tables to practise at home on TTRS. Playing Garage will allow the children to work on the times tables they are unsure of. They will get a heatmap per term which shows what they need to work on.



Mathletics homework will be set and children are expected to complete this. The learning set will reflect what has been taught in school at the time. Teachers will check to see who is completing the assignments at the end of each term. The logins can be found in their yellow reading record.

Mathletics and TTRS share the same login



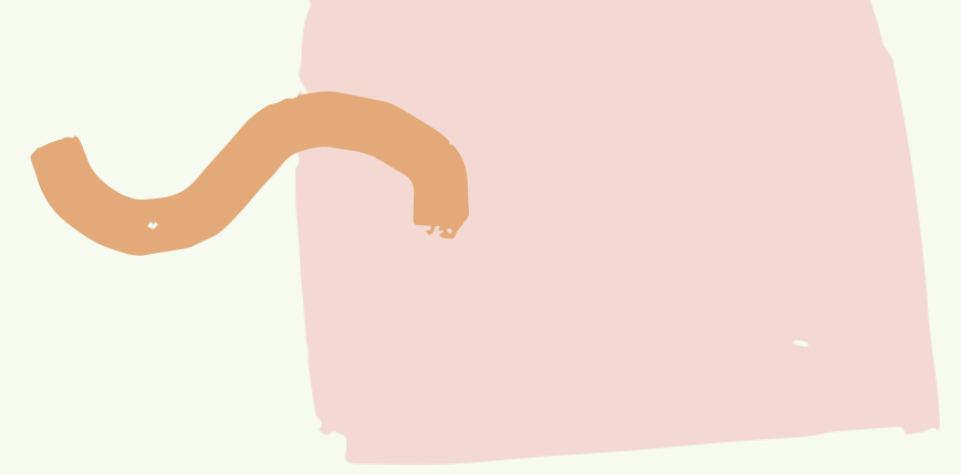
TOPIC HOME LEARNING

Swimming

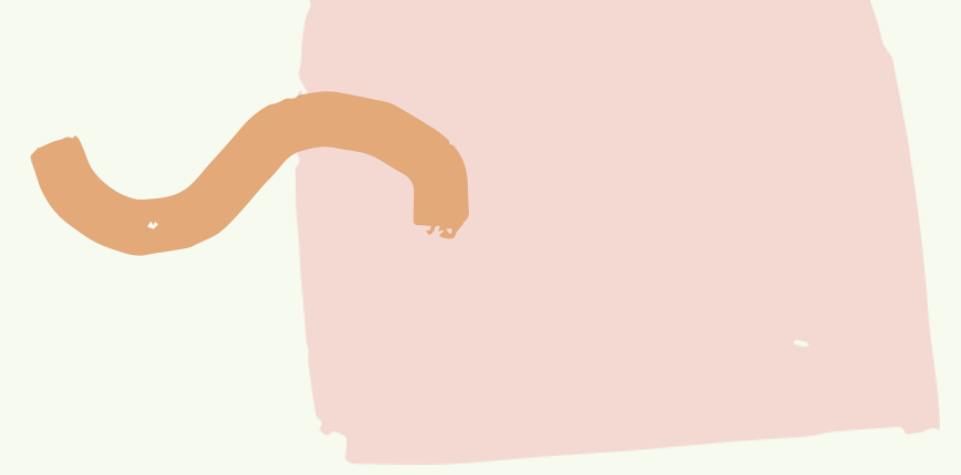
You will need;

EVENTS

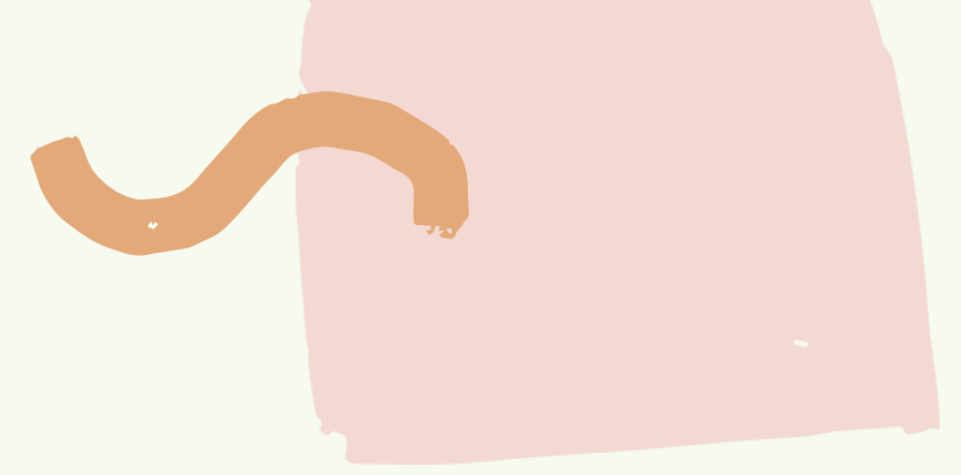


Dates for Parents evenings, classroom afternoons and class assemblies will all be send out on the school newsletter or check the website for information or events and dates.
