# YEAR FIVE INFORMATION

## **Where do I take my child on their first day in Year 5?**

Both of the Year Five classrooms are situated on the playground nearest to the back gate. There will always be an adult from Year 5 to welcome your child into the classroom with a smile! The other adults will encourage your child to put their belongings away and to settle them in the classroom.



## **How important is my child's attendance?**

Very Important! Just like in Year Four we encourage a high level of attendance and punctuality at Repton Manor. Children need to attend school every day unless they are ill. Children who attend every day and arrive on time do better than those who have low attendance and poor punctuality.



# YEAR FIVE INFORMATION

## **Once they are in Year 5, does everything change?**

The Year 4 team will be sharing all of their expert knowledge of their classes with the Year 5 team and will continue to support them during the transition period. The Year Five curriculum builds upon and extends the experiences that children have had in Year Four, they will engage in some extremely exciting topics and take part in some fantastic offsite visits. We want to ensure our children remain motivated, enthused and eager learners so they continue to have opportunities to independently explore during genius hour.

## **A Typical Day in Year 5:**

**8:45-9am:** Early morning learning and registration

**9am-9:30** - Assembly

**9:30-10:30am** Reading lesson

**10.15-10.30am** - DEAR time (Reading focus)

**10:30-10:45am** Break time

**10:45-11:30am** Mathematics

**11:30-12.30pm** Writing

**12.30-1.30pm** Lunchtime

**1.30pm-2.30pm** - Topic/ Genius Hour

**2.30 - 3pm** - Topic/ Computing/ French/ Music

**3-3.15pm** Class Reader

**3.15pm** Children go home

The children will also have PE lessons twice a week. PE days will be confirmed and communicated in September.

# YEAR FIVE INFORMATION

## **Does my child need a PE bag in Year Five?**

No, your child needs to arrive at school in their PE kit on their assigned PE day. This will be communicated via the weekly bulletin.

## **Will my child still bring home a reading book?**

They will bring home accelerated reading books, it remains just as important that your child reads at home daily in Year Five. They will complete a quiz relating to the book they've read, this ensures the children have comprehended the story.

They will also continue to bring home a library book each week that they have independently chosen.

## **Will my child have homework in Year Five?**

They children will be asked to read their reading books each day.

They will have spellings set each week and can practice these on Spelling Shed, it is important that they practice these to developing their knowledge of spelling patterns.

They will be asked to complete home learning challenges from the termly grid. They will continue to use Timetables Rocks Stars to develop their knowledge of timetables. Children can focus on particular Math's skills using Mathematics.

## **Will I still be able to speak to my child's teacher informally?**

Of course! Your child's teacher will be at the door each morning and after school and is available for you to speak to briefly. If you need a longer conversation please be aware after school is preferable.

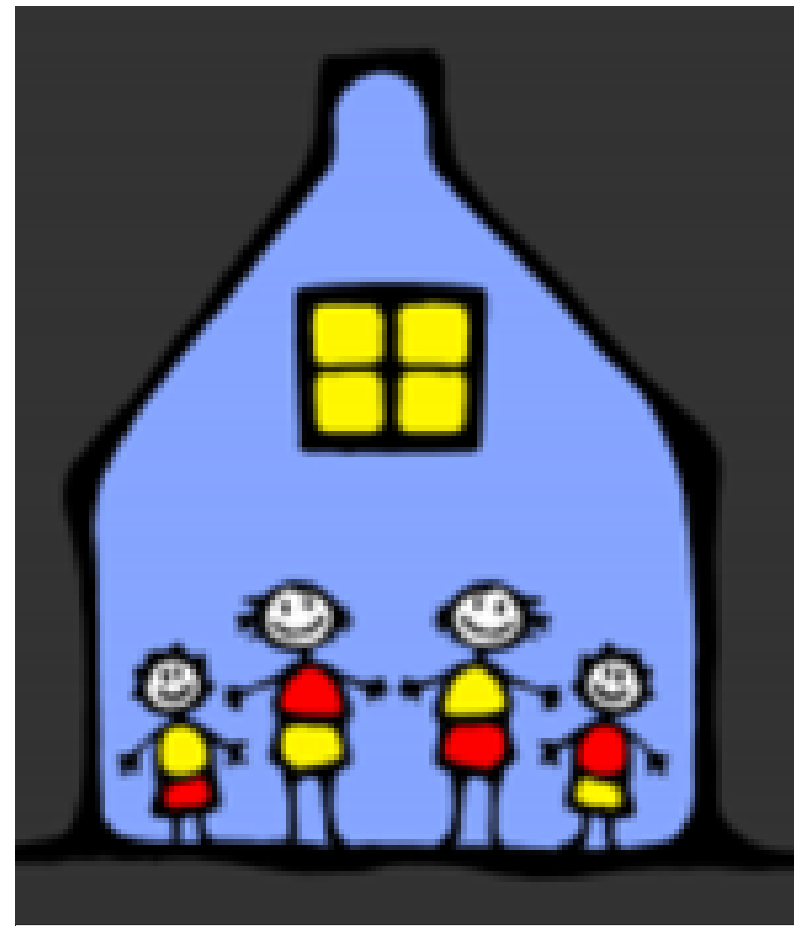

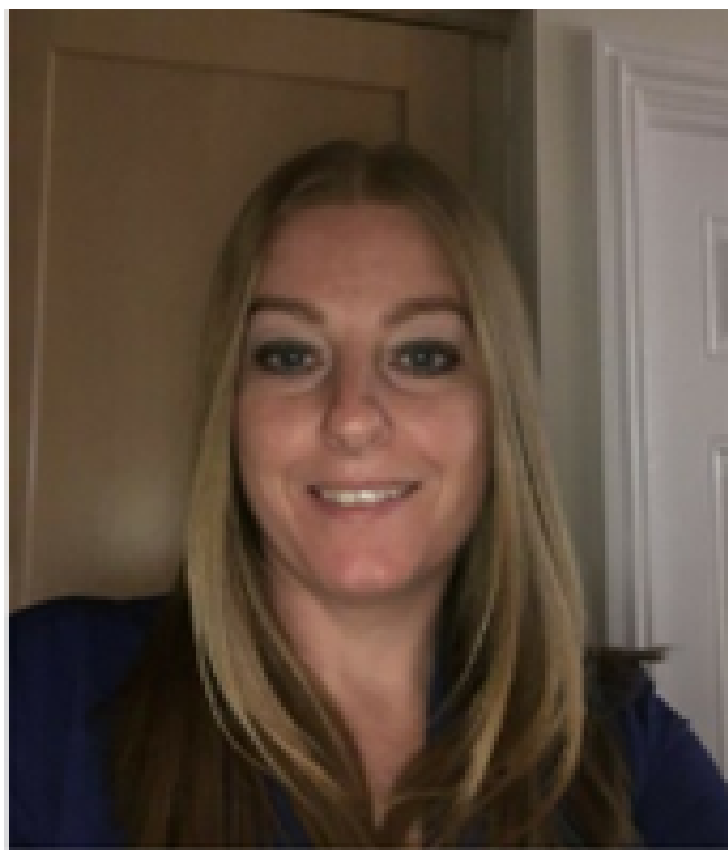

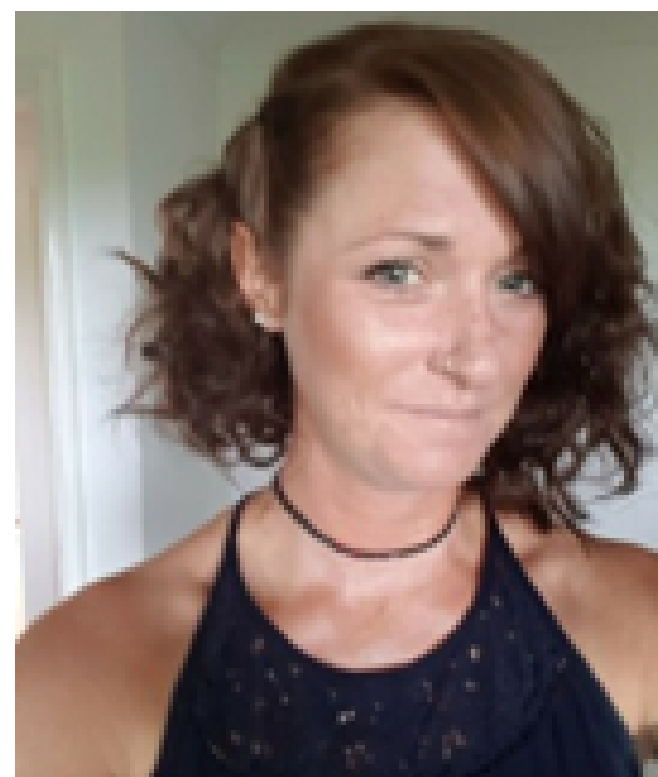
