Maths

In Maths we'll begin with a recap of time related learning from Year 2, looking at o'clock, half past, quarter past and quarter to, then spend some time consolidating our vocabulary and building up to telling the time in 5 minute intervals, reading timetables and calculating journey time. We will move onto a recap of 2D shapes, their name, properties and tessellation.

Using real-life objects, we'll explore 3D shapes, consolidating our use of key vocabulary; vertices, edges and faces. We will also explore mass and capacity in practical ways before the end of term.

Storytelling

Our reading lessons will allow us to explore many Roman related tales and myths, giving us inspiration for our writing and helping us build on our VIPER comprehension skills. In Storytelling, we will be delving into the world of stories, exploring lead female roles such as Boudicca and focusing predominantly on creating a narrative piece. We will be focusing on additional grammar and punctuation elements to help develop our writing and ensure that we will be ready for Year 4.



Topic



In curriculum lessons the children will continue with The Remarkable Romans. Within this topic the children will learn about rulers, sequencing events, myths and gods and the effects the Romans have had on Britain today. In Geography, we will use maps to plot Roman towns and begin using 4 points on a compass. We will design chariots with moving parts, research architecture in Roman Britain and what remains today. In Science, we will explore plants in depth and what they need to survive. In computing, we will learn about branching databases.
