

Our new topic is Ancient Greece. Here are some of the fun things we will be learning about in Term 5 and 6...

Topic

Our new topic for Terms 5 and 6 is Ancient Greece. This is going to be a very exciting topic because it links our new class book, Percy Jackson and the Lightning Thief!

Firstly, we will be learning about what life was like in Ancient Greece and the beliefs people had at the time, including researching different Gods and Goddesses. We will also be exploring what people did for entertainment and the inventions that were made during this time, especially as a lot of them we still use today! We will be finishing our topic by looking at the first Olympics and trying out some of our own Olympic events.

Maths

In Maths this term we will be focusing on decimals and learning how to tell the time. If you can have a practice of telling the time at home that would be brilliant! We will then be learning about money and the properties of shape. Remind yourself of the 2D and 3D shapes!
