
Year 3 Class Newsletter

We are beginning our topic of The Ancient Greeks. Here are some of the exciting things we will be learning this term...

Topic

Our topic for Term 5 is The Ancient Greeks where we will continue to have a strong focus on history where the children will become historians! Maths
