



# What a Wonderful World

## Year 4 Term 4



We are excited to continue to explore states of matter, linked to the water cycle, and living things and their habitats. Our goal is to learn a wider breadth of living things so we can easily identify animals when out and about or when using technology.



In maths this term, our big topic is fractions. We will be looking at converting between improper fractions and mixed numbers, finding equivalent fractions and adding and subtracting fractions. We will also be doing a unit on decimals and looking at how these link with fractions.



For our writing, we will be researching and writing a biography and writing an information report linked to the British coats. Our grammar focus for this term is using commas correctly to mark clauses and using inverted commas to show speech.
