I am an Artist. Create your own space art. Remember to include the mixing of colours.	I am a Computer Programmer. Research and create a presentation on a South American or North American City.

Complete a physical challenge to overcome a fear – This is in relation to our learning about Mordicai Gerstein (The twin tower tightrope walker).
I am a Scientist. Create the Solar System.	I am a Geographer. Recreate a famous structure from North America.
