WHAT ARE WE LEARNING?

Over the next two terms our topics is 'Survival'. Our resilience and survival skills will be put to the test for a range of OAA (outdoor adventurous activities), bush-craft and map making experiences.

In Term 5, children will explore the world through our Geography focus and learn how to use six figure grid references and orienteering themselves using maps.

They might be on a mission to find treasure....or perhaps they might stumble upon a strange animal in the rain forest, helping us write non-chronological reports on exotic creatures.
