We really hope you enjoyed our Dreams topic. We managed to complete some fantastic learning that we are all so proud of. In January, we will be moving onto our Harry Potter topic. We are adding a new exciting topic to our curriculum: The Vikings!

Tapic

During our Harry Potter topic, we will begin by exploring the world of witchcraft and wizardry. We will immerse ourselves in the world of Hogwarts by visiting Harry Potter Warner Brothers Studio on Wednesday 5th January. Using this as a stimulus, we will then explore the key themes of Harry Potter through Cubism. After this, we will be developing our map and 'mischief' skills by studying Marauders Map and creating our own using an 8-point compass for navigation.

After the half term, we will begin our journey across the Nordic seas to reach our destination of 'Viking Mayhem' (our chosen Year 4 production). We will study the everyday life of a Viking, the differences between the roles of men and women in their society and the expansion of their kingdom through raids.

Maths

In maths this term, for Length, we will be looking at comparing measurements. We will be learning to measure the perimeter and area of shapes. We will also be looking at multiplication and division where we will be using the formal written methods to help us solve equations. This leads us nicely into fractions where we will be learning to add, subtract and look at equivalence.
