Please ensure that your child has wellington boots and a waterproof jacket in school everyday so that they can access all areas at playtime.



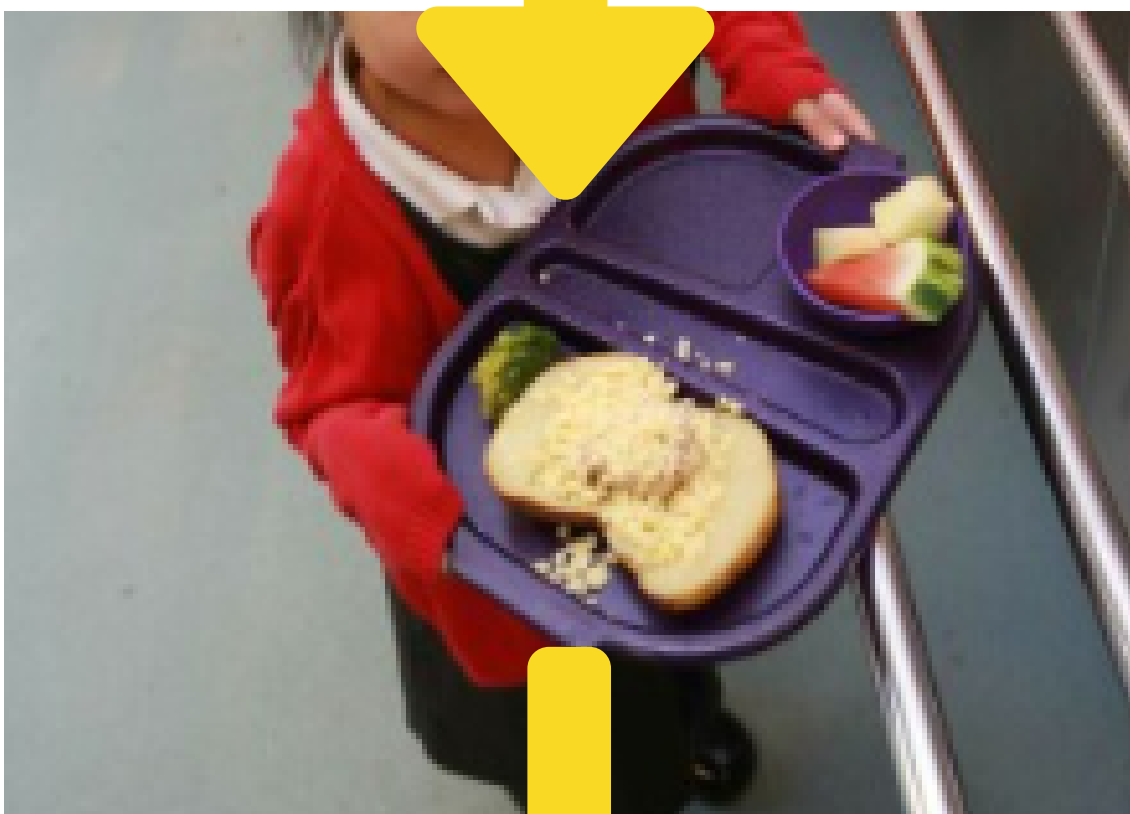
# EATING A HOT DINNER AT LUNCHTIME

draw a face

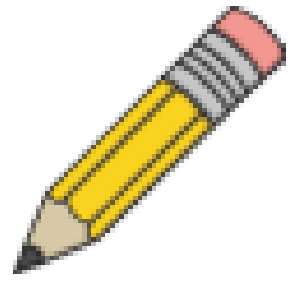



put on my socks

write the first letter

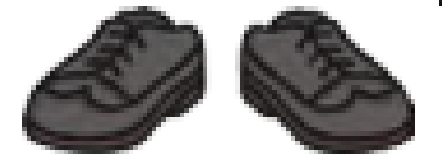
name the colours I use

tidy away my toys

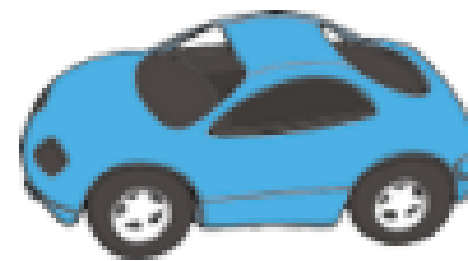
say please when I ask

clear away things I've used

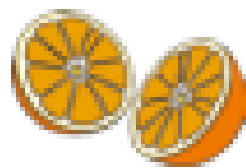
say thank you when I get
