## Outdoor Learning for Year 3 in Term 3 and 4.

We would like to inform you of an exciting opportunity we have been offered from Godinton House. They are offering for us to be part of an outreach project which will provide us with 3 afternoons of outdoor learning for each year 3 class. They will cover skills in outdoor cooking, knot tying, building and lighting fires whilst also developing their confidence in outdoor exploration. This cohort has really benefitted from the opportunity to engage in outdoor learning on previous occasions and we are delighted to be able to resume outdoor learning. Staff from the Year 3 team will be supporting these sessions, alongside an outdoor learning practitioner.

One of the sessions will hopefully allow the children to taste some creations from their cooking. We will of course refer to the allergy/intolerance list that we currently hold for your child but please do let us know if you would rather your child did not sample the food that they'll be cooking.

For these sessions, children will need to bring a change of clothes (or warm clothes to go over their uniform), a coat, snood, hat, gloves, additional thick socks and wellies or outdoor boots (separate to their usual school shoes). Please provide your child with the layers they will need in the current weather to keep them warm for the afternoon session.
