Outdoor Learning -Term 4

We are extremely pleased that we will be able to offer Outdoor Learning lessons again next term. We have an outside provider coming in to deliver lessons, alongside our teachers, who works in several local schools including Greatstone Primary School. Pete has had proven impact at Greatstone and has built great relationships with children and staff there and we are very excited to have him working with us too.
