Communication

- We have an open door policy and parents/guardians are welcome to ask questions or have a conversation with us in the following ways:
 - Where appropriate, at the door in the mornings/after school. Meetings may need to be arranged at the nearest appropriate time.
 - Send an email into the office and they will then forward it onto us. For our own wellbeing, emails will not be responded to after 5.30pm or during weekends. We will endeavour to get back to you the following morning/day. (Please note that we are unable to check emails during the school days so any urgent information should be passed on via a phone call to the school office).

Prepping for the School Day

- Coats, outdoor shoes, PE kits and bags in lockers (please ensure that these are clearly named)
- Water bottles in classroom (children can access these throughout the day)
- Packed lunches on trolley
- School dinners (menus can be found on the website)
- Reading records and reading books are needed in school everyday
- Please ensure that children arrive on time into school as they complete Early Morning Work everyday

End of the School Day

- If anyone else is collecting your child, let the school office know as we are unable to release them if we are not aware
- If you would like your child to walk to meet you at the gate or to walk home alone, an agreement must be signed and returned to the school office.

Timetable

- PE kits are needed in school on Wednesdays and Thursdays
- Outdoor learning will take place on Wednesdays
- RWI-new books will given out Mondays and then books will be handed in on Fridays
- Accelerated Reader-books will be changed once completed, not on set days
- Library-will be visited once a week with the whole class
- Assemblies-celebration assemblies will continue to take place on Fridays

Accelerated Reader

- This week, children will be completing an Accelerated Reader Assessment which gives us their ZPD score. This is two numbers which the children can pick books between these two numbers
- Once the children have finished reading the book, they will need to login to Accelerated Reader to complete the quiz on the book. Once they have done this and have achieved 60%, they will be able to change it.

Green Home Learning Books

- This is where children can practise their spellings, times tables and complete their topic in these books. They should be brought in on Thursdays.
- Children are taught and set spellings on Spelling Shed on Fridays. The spellings are set for each child based on their ability, so not every child will have the same and then they are tested on these on Thursdays. The score will be recorded at the back of the green books.
- All logins for Home Learning will be in the children's yellow contact book.

- Times tables and Maths
 - Times tables and number bonds are a big part of Year 3. Please practise these as much as possible.
 - Children will complete a NB/TT quiz every week.

Topic

- This will be set once every two terms, with the expectation that each child completes at least one piece by the set date.
- Children will share this work with the rest of the class and it will be displayed in our locker area.
