<p><b>Year 3</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>❖ Our PE days are Wednesday and Thursday.</li> <li>❖ Please ensure you sign your child's reading record daily.</li> <li>❖ Pneuma Church trip – Wednesday 6<sup>th</sup> December. Please consent in Arbor.</li> </ul>
<p><b>Year 4</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>❖ Year 4 swimming will commence week beginning 31<sup>st</sup> October. This will be every Tuesday morning and will run through term 2</li> <li>❖ Reminders: Our PE days will be on Tuesdays (Swimming) and Wednesdays. When swimming, as in Year 3, children should come to school in their PE kit with their swimming clothes on underneath. This makes for a quick entrance into the pool and easier changing afterwards. The children will be reassessed when they get there and sorted into groups</li> </ul>
