A message from Mrs Chambers

Dear Families,

Unfortunately, we continue to have regular issues with parking on the roads surrounding the school. As we have said before, parking irresponsibly is incredibly dangerous and it puts the safety of our children who are using these roads at risk.

As you know, our staff welcome our children via the school gates - this is essential to ensure that they come into school happily and that once in school, they are safe and cannot leave again via the gates. Our staff should not need to remind parents of appropriate places to park. For this reason, we have asked the local PCSOs to visit as regularly as they can to monitor the situation. Phil White, our Estates Manager, will also be monitoring the situation throughout the week at peak times.

We ask that parents do not park in designated disabled bays and we strongly advise that parents do not park / stop on the zig zag lines outside the school and adjacent to the side gate at the rear of the school. Not only does this endanger children crossing the road and cause a build-up of traffic, this is also a fineable offence and you could receive 3 points on your licence and a £100 fine.

We take the safety of our children and Repton community very seriously and we do hope that you will all begin to see a change in how the traffic is managed going forward.

A note from Price & Buckland our uniform providers – 'Over the last 12 months we have seen inflation and interest rates rise to levels not seen for quite some time. Whilst both are beginning to come down, salary rises (including the increase in the minimum wage), have meant our costs have increased overall.

On a positive note, since we manufacture most of the garments we sell, we can negate some of the impact of these cost increases.

As a result, whilst we have no choice but to increase some prices, many are staying the same such as our style 2011 Polo Shirt. Also, some are only going up just 50p such as our sweatshirts and cardigans. None of the regular garments shown on our website will be going up in price by more than 50p or 5%.

Any increase will take effect from 1st April'
