Huckleberry Orchard Visit 2024

Dear Parent/Carer,

In Early Years, our Topic in Term 5 is all about animals and habitats. To further enhance the children's understanding of animal habitats, identifying, naming and sorting animals by their homes and describing animal features, we would like to take Year R on a trip to **Huckleberry Orchard** on **Tuesday 7th May 2024 for Miss Iles' Class** and **Thursday 9th May for Miss Boatfield's Class**. These are **morning** visits only. The children will be able to encounter miniature farm animals; stroke, groom, walk and feed them.

The total price of the trip is £25 per child. This includes the cost of the coach journey and private use of the centre. If we do not receive enough funds, we will have to regrettably cancel the event.

On the day of the trip, your child will need to wear school uniform and arrive to school as normal at 8:45am. We will be leaving school after registration and returning by 1.00pm to allow for the usual collection procedure. The children can wear comfortable clothing e.g. wellington boots and jogging bottoms but MUST wear their school jumper. They will NOT need any spending money for the trip. The children will need to bring a drink bottle, sun hat if warm and a light weight waterproof coat.

Children require a packed lunch on this day. All children in Early Years are entitled to a free lunch.
